### Writing Workshop

with Dr. Kimberly Crow

Most of the week is dedicated to scientific writing. **Kimberly Crow** is a German-American social scientist with more than 20 years of experience in research and teaching. As a communication consultant, she is specialized in academic communication. Her writing workshop combines three elements:

#### Coaching on your own text

Across Tuesday and Wednesday, you will work on your individual projects with structured guidance to improve your writing process.

#### Individual feedback

In groups of two, you will discuss your text directly with Kimberly Crow during dedicated feedback slots that run in parallel to the writing sessions. This allows you to receive detailed, individual expert feedback on your work.

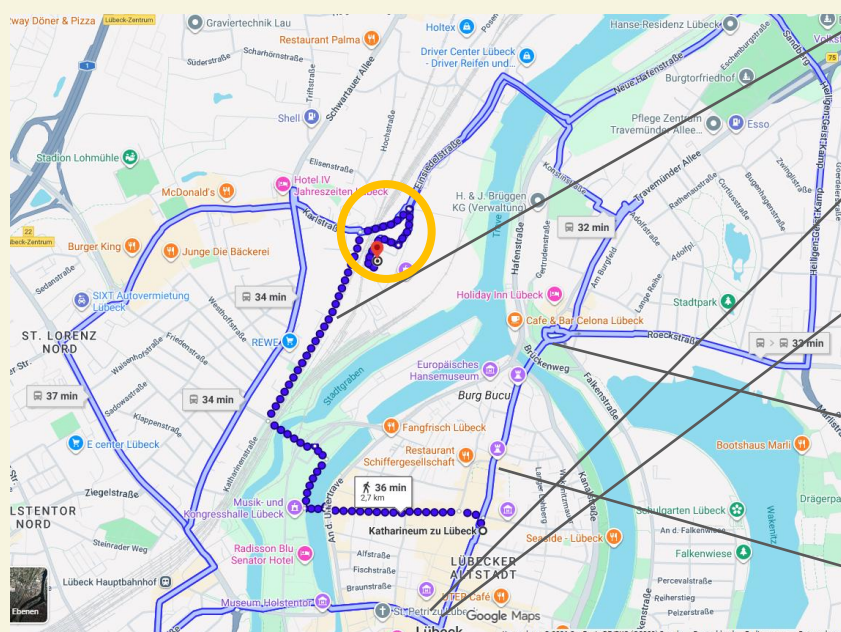
#### Peer feedback

Structured feedback rounds in small, interdisciplinary groups ensure that everyone receives constructive comments on their work and practices providing feedback.

Please bring a piece of text that you are working on (e.g., a paper in progress or a thesis chapter). Think about this in advance, and when relevant, agree with your PI on which piece of text to work on during the summer school. This will allow you to make the most of the week and apply what you learn directly to your work.

17 min ride (8 stops) | ca. 20 min walk

Bus 25 „Gustav-Radbruch-Platz“ →  
„Einsiedelstraße“  
13 min ride (9 stops) | ca. 5 min walk

Bus 31 „Katharineum“ → „Adolfstraße“  
5 min ride (4 stops) | ca. 30 min walk

From the city centre: approx. 2.5 km walking

By public transport: approx. 15 min + 15 min walk depending on the starting point
